

# INTERNSHIP POSITION FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS (ERASMUS+)

The CSCP is offering a **position as an exchange student/ intern** in the Sustainable Infrastructures Products and Services (SIPS) team.

The Collaborating Centre on Sustainable Consumption and Production (CSCP) gGmbH is an independent, non-profit "Think and Do Tank" committed to providing collaborative solutions for a sustainable planet. The Centre was founded in 2005 by the United Nations Environmental Program (UNEP) and the Wuppertal Institute for Climate, Environment and Energy and is headquartered in Wuppertal, Germany. A team of currently 50 multi-disciplinary professionals contributes to the worldwide activities of the Centre.

#### Tasks

The candidate will be involved in the daily project work of the SIPS-team, in particular in the EU H2020 <u>SCALIBUR project</u>: The tasks mainly involve supporting with ongoing activities, such as research, organization of events, engaging with different stakeholders, or the implementation of pilot activities. Further possible tasks are related to assistance in preparing presentations and reports, as well as translations. The applicant will be encouraged to work in further CSCP-projects and activities, depending on her/ his interests.

#### Competencies

- Good academic and analytical skills. Ability to draft clearly and concisely, very good language skills.
- Good interpersonal skills, works collaboratively with colleagues to achieve organisational goals, ability to develop and maintain effective work relationships with different national and cultural backgrounds with sensitivity with respect for diversity.
- Working experience and familiarity with sustainability topics in general. Additionally, knowledge on the topics of circular economy/ bio-based industry/ social innovation and entrepreneurship is a plus, though not mandatory.
- Other required skills: Good skills in basic computer usage, including internet searches. In particular, good working knowledge of MS Office, Intra-Internet, e-mail applications etc.





## Language

The first working language at CSCP is English, therefore fluency in written and spoken English is necessary. Additionally, since the applicant will be working closely with the Greek SCALIBUR-pilot, Greek as a native language is helpful.
